## BRITAIN SHOWS WHITE ENSIGN

The Royal Mavy shows its might. At Portland harbour, Viscount Hall, First Lord of the Admiralty, goes aboard the flagship of the Home Floot (the 45,000-ten battleship Duke of York) which loads the Mavy's atumn exercise to the West Indies.
