The voice is that of Robert Mensies, Australian epposition leader. This year, his own country, with a population less than that of Greater Lendon, experts a hundred and fifty million bushels of grain, runs its cattle bords to well over fourteen million and raises a hundred million sheep. Its mountains are solid mineral wealth....

In Africa, terdy development brings one hundred and thirty seven thousand tons of edible eils from the relatively small ground mut scheme. Canada is rapidly becoming the world's granary, though its working population is little over a quarter of that of Britains.

Its mineral wealth is well nigh incalculable, in copper and nighel output it leads the world. A score of timber-hungry nations turn to Canada for help in pressing schemes of reconstruction.
