

WESTMINSTER WEDDING

10,000 sightseers wait for five hours outside St. Margaret's, Westminster to see the Society Wedding of the year. Lady Margaret Egerton, 29-year-old lady-in-waiting to Princess Elizabeth, weds Mr. John Colville, the Princess' secretary. Following the bride, who wears a pale pink dress of silk brocade with long tight fitting sleeves - come her bridesmaids - among them, Princess Margaret in pink and grey tulle.

As the couple leave the Church, crowds crane their necks to glimpse some of the 1,000 guests - 100 of whom were shut out. The King and Queen are there, also Queen Mary (as stately and dignified as ever) as well as the Princess Royal.
