In the course of the sitting of the General Assembly on November 18th, at about 7.30 p.m., Garry Davies, the 'World Citizen' No. 1, intervened in order to address the assembly. He was immediately surrounded by Police Inspectors of UNO.

Garry Davies, who had started speaking from one of the side balconies was hustled away amid considerable hubbub.

Meanwhile the President suspended the sitting and a considerable stir was shown in the circle surrounding Mr. Vishinsky. An unknown person profited by the general confusion over Davies' outburst to leave from the other balcony. He was arrested, as well as a number of journalists, photographers, and cameramen.
