If you're a fisherman, here's a story of one that didn't get away. If you're a surfer you'll be glad that he didn't. If you're neither, just grab your seat and get ready for thrills. John Platt and Hoel Dougherty of Bondi are going out in this tiny ten feeter to fish for sharks. Hooks are baited with fish which in themselves would satisfy the average angler but these two are after bigger game. And here it is. A strike! He's a 14 feeter timer shark much lenger than the fisherman's craft They're going to need more than fisherman's luck. This may be ekay in a fair sixed ship but in this dinghy -- oh boy! There's a choppy sea. It's dengerous just standing in the best but when the shark fights ... it's hang on, or go overboard. The tiger's one of the sea's most vicious mensters, and one of its most determined fighters. The powerful brute could everturn the tiny craft and must be handled carefully. Platt's hands are sore and blistered from constant jarring as the shark twists and dives, trying to break loose. He's drewning the shark -- strange but true.

The fight's mearly over but a tiger shark'streacherous to the last kick. It's still too early to take chances, but they hand it alongside to get a rope round its tail. They're towing it behind the dinghy because its too big to fit inside. It sounds like a fisherman's tale but these boys can prove it. And when surfers know this tiger shark was hocked only a few yards from where they were catching waves off Ben Buckler — yes, they'll still be back there towerrow. They have seen a let of welves on Bendi Beach, but they don't often get such a close up view of a shark.
