Sound & Silent.

The Russian officers visit Lord Provost of Edinburgh - shots walking into City Chambers - shots coming out with Lord Provost waiting on step for cars - Lord Provost speaks to them and is answered in broken English - they go to their cars and Provost waves them away.

Silent - Officers and ratings on jetty at South Queens Ferry - shots of City Chambers.

Cameraman: J. Turner 7th & 8th February 1949.  
Location: Dumfermline and Edinburgh 350-ft

Vice Admiral Archer, Flag Officer Scotland goes aboard barge for official call on Russians - Russian officers step ashore to lunch with Admiral and to visit Dumfermline Provost - Russian Commander arrives at Dumfermline City Hall and is greeted by the Mayor Mr. Gellatly - Russians leave Dumfermline City Hall - 2 shots of Dumfermline City Hall - Arrival of Russians at City Chambers, Edinburgh, for lunch with Lord Provost of Edinburgh - shots of Russians with Lord Provost after the lunch - Russians visit Holyrood House but do not get out of cars (shots of cars with Holyrood House in background - Russians visit Arthur's Seat and look out over rails at view - quick shot of view.
