SPEECH DE GAULLE

General de Gaulle spoke yesterday at Lille and Valenciennes. From balcony / of the Town Hall of the Lille :

"Their are terrible means which may be employed on the side of the Justice and Liberty by ourselves and our friends if, unhappily, these are ever put to the test. Before the foreign menace we stand with our friends, a body of free men who intend to remain free"
