Bristal

Britain's first all-aluminium pre-fab schools - constructed to defeat the steel-shortage - are completed at Locklease Estate, Bristel, in a record nine months. Minister of Education, George Toulinson, accompanied by the Mayor of Bristel, opens four of the schools which, together, will accommedate 2,000 children.

The cost works out at about £180 a place, admittedly high, says the Minister, but still comparing favourably with other types of primary schools.
