

49/32BRITON LEAPS TO FIRST PLACE

In the Palais des Sports, Paris, top riders from six European nations compete in the highlight of France's premier horse show - the Grand Prix. The Duchess of Windsor is there as Spain's No. 1, Francesco Guyoya rides his dappled grey around the stiff course.

Riding for the French team is Micheline Canare - one of the few women who have won international honours. With grace and elegance, she completes this tough test for rider and horse.

Leading the British team is Colonel Llewellyn. On the previous day, he won the "Prix du Gentleman." Now in faultless style, he again scores top points.

Over the last jump and Colonel Llewellyn is the winner. His victory gives the British team the first place in the jumping event of the season.
