MISTERY BLAZE: DETECTIVES CALLED IN

Stratford, London. Smoke pours from a corner building, as firemen battle to bring under control the fifth fire in a week to strike within a half-mile area in the East End. Mystery cloaks the worst outbreak of suspected arson in recent years. Scotland Tard detectives are investigating. From neighbouring houses, bees flood the store - a repesitory of Government surplus goods. Six firemen are injured by explosives.

A senior fire-officer is first inside the building. As the blase is checked, wreckage is searched for class, to how it started.

After nine hours, 100 firemen are still "damping down" the £30,000 inferno.

Meanwhile, the pelice - fearing a new wave of fire-raising - order redoubled watch on all factories and warehouses centaining inflammable material.
