

Acrobat on top of St Pierre's Cathedral steeple

The Steeple of St-Peter's Cathedral at Geneva (Switzerland) is being rebuilt.

A scaffolding surrounds it. The workers who repair the steeple must not be afraid to climb high.

Among them is Henry Viatte 23 years old son of acrobat. He has chosen a good job.

After the working-hours, he climbs up to the highest point of the steeple (86 meters high) and fixes a bar.

He executes a few acrobatic tricks.
