

KING AT WINDSOR CASTLE WEDDING

Windsor has its first royal wedding for many months, as the young bridal attendants arrive at St. George's Chapel - unperturbed by the presence later of eminent guests, including members of the Royal Family and several Cabinet Ministers. Though still convalescing, the King - making his first public appearance since his illness - looks fit as he walks to the Chapel with the Queen.

And here comes the happy pair. The bride - Miss Caroline Mary Lascelles, daughter of the King's Private Secretary, Sir Alan Lascelles - and bridegroom, Mr. Anthony Lyttleton, son of Mr. Oliver Lyttleton.

The King and Queen leave for the Waterloo Chamber of Windsor Castle, where His Majesty toasted the health of the bride and bridegroom.
