125,000 eggs are electrically treated to produce chickens quickly.

And every day 5 to 6,000 chickens and ducklings are born.

This farm needs 15 to 20 tons of food per day for the poultry.

A NEW CROSS OF SALZBURG CATHEDRAL

Thousands of people attended the consecration of the new Cross on the reconstructed dome of Salzburg Cathedral. After celebrating Holy Mass on the Domplatz Dr. Echracher, Archbishop of Salzburg, consecrated the Cross. This was followed by a grand procession through the streets of the town. It was a highly picturesque scene in brilliant sunshine which enchanted all onlookers by the beauty and variety of the many local costumes of the Salzburg Province and the sumptuous robes of the clergy. The massive wooden cross used in the Passion Plays of Erl and the iron cross of the Catholic Youth Organisation of Zell am See were carried high above the procession symbolising the people's faith. After the procession the new Cross was raised on the dome which had been destroyed during the war and only recently rebuilt.
