## GUARDE MOVIE INTO LONDON DOCKS

In the second week of the London dock-strike, the Army is called out to unload ships lying idle in the Thames. Guardanon - the first of twolve hundred detailed as emergency stevedores - arrive at the Royal Vietoria Dock, to unload most from the 10,000-tonner "ARCENTINA STAR."

The ship's crew extend no hard feelings - but no beloing hand. A mixed party of Seets, Granadier and Coldstream Guards manhandle frozen sides of beef and sheep carcases from the ship's "cold hatches." Here, the temperature is 8 degrees below freezing - no pienic for the Guardsmen, some of whom are only just back from Malaya. The "ARCENTINA STAR" was chosen as the first ship in order to try to preserve its scheduled three-day turn-round. But with 5,000 tens of most still absard, experts believed that it would take inexperienced troops at least a week to clear it. 96 ships are new strike-bound (as part of a plan, the Gabinet new believes) instigated by Communists to disrupt the nation's economic life. Meanwhile, the burden again falls on the fighting services, as deadlock reigns in deckland.
