At Northolt, Sir Stafford Gripps arrives back after a five-weeks rest-cure in a Swiss nursing home. Looking fitter than for many months, Sir Stafford returns th face a heavy programme of dellar talks, at the Washington Conference in September.

On the block moorlands Horth of Greenfield, near Oldham, a Dakota airliner erashes in the mist with a loss of 24 lives; the remaining 8 of the 32 passengers and crew are injured.
