A lost legion returns. A trainload of Austrian prisoners of war arrives in Vienna from Soviet Russia. A chink of the Iron Curtain was raised to allow these 400 men - former soldiers in Hitler's army - to come home after four years and longer in Russian prison camps. Their loved ones greet them. Vienna station becomes the scene of pathetic reunions - and tragic disappointments, for there are many who will never return.
