A monster rally in Shanghai celebrates Communism's greatest victory since the coup in Czechoslovakia. Five months ago, the troops of MAO TSE-TUNG marched into Shanghai unopposed. That victory was celebrated in July at a gigantic parade in what is today the largest Red City in the world, now so isolated, that these pictures took three months to reach Britain. In those three months, the Reds have changed the face of China and brought the world's largest country within the Communist empire.
