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HATTON GARDEN BEATS JEWEL BANDITS.

Sparkling diamonds - their value running into millions, are giving Hatton Garden alcopless nights. With London now a world centre for diamonds, jowel bandits have made this city thoroughfare their favourite target. There have been widespread thefts of preciens stones worth hundreds of thousands. To foil the thieves, Hatten Garden now has its own giant strong room - available to every jowel merchant in the district. Constructed at a cost of more than £20,000, a two-foot wide beam-and-burglarpreef door - (eperated by a combination that has to be worked by at least two men) - epens up a labirymth of safes.

In the vestibule, to which dealers are taken by an automatic lift, the identity of each caller is double-checked, before he is admitted. Alarm signals connect direct with Scotland Yard's control room and pelice cars are within a minute's drive of the building. It is the only one of its kind in Britain and has taken more than six months to build. Nearly a theusands individual safes are contained within this mass of steel and reinforced concrete.

To jewel merchantsthe syper-safe provides conferting security for their dismonds and other precious stones. Jewel thieves will have to transfer their activities to other countries.
