

"MADE IN GERMANY" MAKES NEWS

Back on the world market come the labels marked **Made-in-Germany**. Heading a parade of gadgets is the pocket bicycle. Carried in a small bag, it can be put together - and taken apart - in less than three minutes. It costs no more than the ordinary machine.

Object of the lightweight frame is to improve spring suspension on bad roads. Designed by a Munich mechanic, the folding bike sets out for a place in the pockets of cycling enthusiasts everywhere.

Gadget No. 2 goes on show on the Starnbergersee. This is one for the traveller, who doesn't mind roughing it a bit. Recommended as a cure for seasickness, it's a water walker - the latest craze among Bavarian water sports fans. A simple instrument with complicated measurements, it's a bike without wheels - but with twice as much need for pedalling.
