Elevated shot of Princess Elizabeth being presented with bouquet in the old part of the town before planting a maple tree to commemorate the links with Canadian servicemen who were stationed in the town. The Canadian High Commissioner, Mr. L.D. Wilgress, speaks: 'Your Royal Highness, Your Grace, Ladies and gentlemen, the planting of this tree commemorates many associations between this district of Sussex and the Canadian army in the late war on a most significant occasion. It strengthens the indissoluble bonds which united our two peoples in a common cause.
2. S.C.U. '..... Your Royal Highness, that she does honour to Canada by the planting of this maple tree, whose leaf is the most familiar of all the emblems of Canada. I extend to her the loyal thanks of the Canadian people and to the town of Crawley. (Applause). Princess turns to hand her bouquet to someone.
