

JETS JOIN UP WITH THE NAVY

From the aircraft carrier ILLUSTRIOUS - at exercise in the Atlantic - come first pictures of the Navy's own jet fighter - the Vickers Supermarine "Attacker" - a descendant of the "Spitfire." With aircrew fighters obsolete for modern warfare, Rolls-Royce Hone-powered jet "Attackers" will form the Royal Navy's first operational jet squadron - and will give a headache to the carrier's key man - the "bats," who guides them home. Despite heavy weather, first trials are 100 per cent successful. With a maximum speed of 600-miles-an-hour, the "Attacker" will give the Navy the world's most up-to-date air arm.
