The King and Queen, accompanied by Princess Margaret, meet 1,000 King Scouts - on parade in the quadrangle of Windsor Castle for St. George's Day. Scouts and guides, they represent 29 countries - Commonwealth and foreign. Each of them holds the highest award for proficiency - the King's Scout Badge. Together, they make up the world's noblest youth movement - an inspiration to the nations they come from and an example to the nations who bar them.

As London's dock strike enters its second week troops are called in to speed the turn-around. With 13,000 men out and 84 ships idle, the Army does the housewife a good turn by unloading food-stuffs first of all. The stoppage, which began with the expulsion of three men from their Union, has been condemned by Union Leaders and the Government. Determined to break the strike, the Cabinet will send in 1,000 extra troops a day so that "Operation Springtide" may bring home the bacon.
