## 10,000 WATCH ROYAL GARTER SERVICE

A page of history comes to life at Windsor. With traditional splondour - attended by un-traditional weather - a procession of mediaeval pageantry heralds the annual service of the Order of the Gerter. The King and Queen - as Severeign and First Lady of the Order - walk along a route lined by Household Cavalry to St. George's Chapel, there to give thanks for the foundation of this Order of Chivalry.

Respiondent in their colourful robes, the King and Queen - attended by scarlet-elad pages - leave the Chapel past a guard of honour comprising Enights of the Garter. Lord Halifax - Chanceller of the Order - is among them. Founded more than 600 years ago, the garter blue ribbon and its motto "Evil be to him who evil thinks" serves as a reminder of British greatness. There as spectators on this occasion are Frincess Margaret and the Duchess of Gloupester.

With the Dachess of Kent is her sister, Princess Olga of Tugoslavia. Lords Portal and Montgomery are worthy successors to the Enights of Greay.
