Things are a little more bectic over in New York. Onlookers joer as 5,000 Communists go on parade. Eugene Dennis and other convicted Communist leaders - at present on bail - review the marchers - who seen come under a fire of eggs and tomatees. The only serious incident of the afternoon starts se suddenly no one knows how it began.

When order was restored some of the more active demonstrators came in for a short police-guarded holiday.
