

STRASBOURG'HOUSE OF EUROPE' HANDED OVER

Strasbourg greets Mr. Churchill - first representative of fifteen nations to reach the new House of Europe for the second year's Meeting of the Council of Europe. Count Sferna, for Italy, Reynaud and Schumann for France - former friend and foe alike - meet to discuss how to make the most of the economic strength left in a mutilated Europe. The flag of Western Germany is among those hoisted for a historic session. By 90 votes to 23 Monsieur Spaak of Belgium is re-elected President.
