Like a toy train overturned by a child's impatient hand the wrecked Irish Mail sprawls in the cold light of day. Hurtling through the night, with 500 returning holiday-makers embeard, bound from Holyhead to Eusten, the express crashed into a light engine. Coaches were flung off the rails as the interlocked engines ploughed on ... and even greater horror threatened. A following goods train laden with explosives would have run into the wreck but for the fireman of the Mail and the guard of a goods train, who ran back to step it.

As firemen climbed down, houses turned on their lights to light the way. Resource crows found dead and living trapped in the wreekage. Six were killed, 34 injured. To the bereaved and to the injured goes the sympathy of all.
