

FIREMEN HURT IN BIG LONDON FIRE

London firemen tackle the fiercest blaze of the year at a Thameside warehouse as one hundred tons of paraffin wax goes up in flames, taking the warehouse with it. Four firemen are burned, several overcome by fumes as 25 pumps and two firefloats fight to keep the flames from spreading to two oil plants, neighbouring warehouses and an extensive coal dump.

Low water delayed action from the fire-floats and a giant crane collapsed before it could be saved. Streams of burning molten wax make the work hard and dangerous. Over here to study our fire-fighting methods, Danish firemen help to save valuable stocks of food in warehouse and lighters, as London fights one more battle against fire.
