DIRTY WORK AT THE CROSSROADS

Another boundary incident flares up in Berlin as Red troops seize 175 yards of road in the British zone and set up barriers and road controls. From the Russian zone, East German police travel this stretch on their way to the shooting-range. Because it's illegal to carry weapons in the British zone they are arrested. That is the law and Britain stands by it. To get round it, Russia tries to claim the stretch of road is in the Soviet Zone.

Cameramen watch as men of the Manchesters raise the barriers and re-open the road. What will the Reds do now?

Cameramen hide because the Russians don't want publicity of their discomfiture as the British guard takes over.

Support comes from British H.Q. - just in case, but the Manchesters grin as the storm fizzles out in their tea-cups.
