## BRITISH FOIL COMMENTS? PLAN

The new Communist Headquarters in West Germany (opened enly six weeks ago) are decked with "Tenny Go Heme" and other anti-British slogans as security police and the Dusseldorf Police Commissioner arrive to take over. A 48-hour requisition notice has been ignered, so direct action is taken. From here the Reds were organising the banned march on nearby Dortmand and demonstrating in the Ruhr.

From the 150 effices nearly 500 Communists are turned out, but apart from shouting and chanting slegans there's no trouble. The building was requisitioned as the quickest way to break up a danger centre. With swift German action in other centres the threatened weekend trouble fissled out. Only prompt, firm action can cope with the world's greatest menace - Communism.
