Wilf Mannion's playing a storming game and from a slide-rule pass Bailey puts England two up at half-time.

Leading two-nil, England keep up the pressure, but a dangerous attack is broken up by Ray Daniels. He pushes the ball through to Bryn Allan and from his pass centre-ferward Trever Ford scores the first Welsh goal.

But England come back as Wilf Mannien scores their third goal.
