ENGLAND V. WALES FOOTBALL

At Roker Park, England, in white, field three new caps against Wales and all eyes are on Spurs left-winger Les Medley as he tricks the Welsh captain Wally Barnes. Over goes a typical centre to Bailey's feet but Goal-keeper Hughes is there. Leslie Compton, capped at 39, watches as team-mate Lionel Smith loses the ball to Mal Griffiths. The Leicester right-winger starts a Welsh attack and finally beating Smith passes inside, but Williams stops Clark's shot and clears.

From a Milburn pass Bailey scores first bleed for England.

Wilf Mannion's playing a starring game and from a slide-rule pass Bailey puts England two up at half-time.

Leading two-nil, England keep up the pressure, but a dangerous attack is broken up by Ray Daniels. He pushes the ball through to Bryn Allan and from his pass centre-forward Trevor Ford scores the first Welsh goal.

But England come back as Wilf Mannion scores their third goal.

One of the best internationals of recent years ends with England winning, despite another brilliant Ford goal for Wales.
