

MEMORIAL TO LLOYD GEORGE

At Llanystumdwy they remember a boy who rose to be a great leader of men, for he began here in the little village school. Now, a college is to replace his school. The gates to this new world of knowledge already stand, a gift of the people of Caernarvon. And on this day, the birth anniversary of the boy who grew to greatness, in the presence of his widow, they are dedicated.

Of 18th century pattern, the gates bear the arms of Caernarvon, whose Mayor makes the formal presentation.
