At Chalk River, Canada's huge new atomic pile makes the atom work for man's well-being. Directed by Dr. Keyes, it's the only place where the Cobalt 60 isotope is in production. Radioisotopes - which must be handled in thick lead containers - are tell-tales which are fed into a body and tracked by radiography in today's attack on internal diseases. They're also used similarly in industry. What goes on inside this box we're not allowed to show you: it's that secret. For instance, incidental discoveries made at this plant have turned out to be vital for speeding American work on the H-bomb, although Canada plans only to make the atom bring good to man.
