U.N. FORCES CROSS HAN RIVER

United Nations tanks bombard the far shore to cover troops in assault craft forcing a crossing of the Han River near Seoul. Reports now say Seoul is once more in allied hands. As the guns keep up a steady barrage, more troops pour across to enlarge the bridgehead. Within a matter of hours a foot-bridge is thrown across the Han. Soon the first Chinese prisoners are being marched to the rear.

Once across the infantry advances cautiously with fighter support.

Dramatic front-line pictures give some idea of the hard campaigning conditions. An advanced unit runs into an enemy pocket and opens up. Machine-guns become red-hot and are cooled with snow.
