

PRESIDENT AURIOL IN CANADA

At West Point, American cadets parade in honour of President Auriol, who decorates Major-General Irving, their Commandant, at the conclusion of his visit to America. Sandhurst of America, West Point prides itself on the ceremonial drill of its cadets.
