

51/42DAM FINE FISH POND

Loch Faskally (the other side of the dam) is to become a fisherman's paradise. Created as part of a North of Scotland Hydro-Electric scheme, the loch already has some fish. Now as chairman Tom Johnson watches, they're giving it more. Nearly 7-thousand yearling trout (some marked by cutting their fins) will be let loose in the loch.

Fuel Minister Noel Baker is there; he's an authority on cuts!

Tom Johnson will tip the babies in to mark the opening of the fishing season. You'd think they'd use electric eels, as it's a hydro-electric scheme loch! To help salmon upstream for spawning, there's a grand staircase at the dam.

They don't have to leap here. From each step to the next there's a wide pipe up which they swim. He'll find it in time. And down the same pipe the baby salmon drift when it's time to go to sea.
