

AMATEUR GOLF FINAL

At Perthcawl Charles Coe drives off in the all-American final against 41-year-old Dick Chapman, who's reached the final for the third time in four years. Halving six of the first seven holes, Chapman is one up as they approach the eighth. If he misses his putt, Coe can win the hole to make it all square. Chapman putts.

It's a dead stymie! It's any odds Coe can't hole out without hitting Chapman's ball.

Coe is playing grand golf, but Chapman's giving nothing away. At the end of 27 holes he's one up. And that's the turning-point. Coe, the 27-years-old oil salesman loses three out of the next four, and Chapman's four up. Coe chips out of the rough at the 32nd. Chapman plays his winning shot.
