Channel Race after 7 hrs. 49 mins.

SALLY BAKER - Malmo. Age: 39 (not to be disclosed)
1929: Swan Channel in 12 hrs. 22 mins.
1932: Race between Sweden and Iceland, 30 miles in 17 hrs. 30 mins.
Best Jenny Ekmansgard's record by 12 hours
1932: Sweden to Iceland, 25 miles in 13 hrs. 6 mins. Has trained
for Channel all winter.
