1st COVERAGE

Sequence 1 Crew getting ready - stores and equipment going aboard - crew going aboard and planes taking off.

Sequence 2 Airfield at Keflavik in Iceland. Crew servicing plane - planes waiting to take off and some shots showing barrenness of Iceland.

Sequence 3 Aerial shots over Greenland showing the mountains near the coast - pack ice floating on the sea. Two shots showing Plane's shadow on the ice cap. Central Greenland is all ice.

Sequence 4 Lincoln bomber flying past snow covered mountains and shots of glaciers. The shots of the Lincoln are taken over Iceland as the two planes were 1/2 hours flying time away from each other on the Greenland flight.
