3. C.U. Take with starter Mr. P. Main. Royal Aero Club Official supervising. The record attempt. he waves flag and holds two strings which pull out plugs from fuselage which starts cameras.

ROLL TWO SILENT.

1. Mr. Thomas Prickett, the pilot, in the Meteor before flight.
2. Putting Camera into plane and R.A.C. Official sealing same.
3. Mr. Main replacing plugs to stop camera after flight.
4. Mr. Main - Cut-in putting in camera plugs before flight.
