At least eleven are dead, fifty seriously injured and in hespital and scores more or less hurt as the result of a so-far unexplained rail disaster at Wooden near Northampton. With seven hundred onboard - half of them just screes from Ireland - the Breakfast Special from Liverpeel to Eusten jumped the rails at a tunnel, ploughed on for a quarter of a mile, then crashed over an embenkment.

Shattered and overturned coaches block all lines, and main line expresses are diverted. Rushing up from the south, the Royal Soot pulled up just short of the wreekage and its passengers joined these rendering first aid. To these bereaved gees the sympathy of all. But for the mercy of Providence their number might have been much greater.
