COUNTESS MOUNTBATTEN'S APPEAL

At the Warner Theatre on Saturday, 22nd. September, their Royal Highnesses The Princess Elizabeth and the Duke of Edinburgh will attend the World Premiere of "THE LADY WITH A LAMP", the film which tells the story of Florence Nightingale. It stars Anna Neagle and Michael Wilding. The entire proceeds will be given to the Royal College of Nursing Educational Fund.

Included in the programme is a short film in which Edwina, Countess Mountbatten of Burma, C.I., G.B.E., D.C.V.O., thanks everyone for giving their support to a cause which was very dear to the heart of Florence Nightingale herself.

Speaking from a replica of Florence Nightingale's room in South Street, Mayfair, she explains that the purpose of the Royal College of Nursing's Educational Fund, for which it is hoped to raise £500,000 is to give further training to State-Registered nurses. At the Royal College of Nursing they are trained as Matrons, posts of the highest responsibility. Nurses can also become Sister Tutors so that they in turn can train young nurses entering the profession.

At this juncture Countess Mountbatten announces that "The Lady with a Lamp" is being shown throughout the British Commonwealth and that all those people seeing it for the first time will be subscribing to this Fund.

She then introduces nurses from the following countries and each one tells of the benefits which she is receiving under the Scheme:-

Australia, the Bahamas, South Africa, Scotland, Wales Northern Ireland, India, British West Indies - Jamaica, Malaya, Cyprus, New Zealand - Christchurch, Pakistan, Canada - Vancouver.

The film ends with a farewell speech to Princess Elizabeth and the Duke of Edinburgh in which Countess Mountbatten refers to the curtailment of their holiday at Balmoral and wishes them God-speed on their voyage to Canada and a safe return.
