### ADVANCE INFORMATION

#### Patrons.

THE LADY ABERCONWAY, Author of "Dictionary of Cat Lovers".  
Owner of 6 British Short-Hair Cats. Her ambition is to raise in popularity the status of the British Short-Hairs.

LADY ARKELL, Breeder and exhibitor of Chocolate Point Siamese, advocates the importation of Serum from America to combat gastric enteritis which causes a very high mortality in pedigree cats.

Compton Mackenzie, Lover of Siamese. Keeps 14 of this breed at his home in the Orkneys. Has very strong opinions regarding the Kink at the tip of the Siamese tail. Considers this to be a virtue and should not be bred out as is fashionable with present day breeders.

Alicia Markova. A great lover of cats but is not able to own one as she is constantly travelling.

Beverley Nichols. Favourite breed Siamese, owner of two black Half Breeds "Rose" and "Cavalier".

Michael Joseph. Author and Publisher who made famous his cat "Charles" in his book of that title.

Of the entries which will number well over a 1,000, 26 breeds of cats will be represented. Outstanding exhibits will be the Burmese owned by Mrs. France of Derby. There are only 2 Adult specimens in the Country and these will be on show with a litter born 2 months ago.

"Stonor Spiv", voted by public ballot at last years show to be the most popular cat in Britain, will be on view. Probably the most publicised cat in the world, having appeared on thousands of posters for National Savings Campaign.

Quarantine regulations make it impossible for cats to be exhibited from abroad but to overcome this a feature of the show will be an International Photographic Competition. Entries from France, Sweden, Switzerland, Denmark, Holland, U.S.A. and Canada will compete side by side.

From Switzerland will come Mdme. Bridgett and from France Mdme. Ravel to judge at the show. Both have the distinction of being the first continental judges to officiate at a British show since the war.

The ordinary household cat will have equal opportunity with the blue blooded aristocrats with lengthy pedigrees.

All profits from the show will be devoted to the Feline Research Fund of the Animal Health Trust, for investigation into cat ailments, particularly virus diseases such as cat influenza which causes so much havoc amongst kittens.
