I have today received some film from the Korean Theatre which includes about 100 ft. or so of H.M.S. AMETHYST in the Han River estuary. There are shots of her guns firing, thus returning to the Communists some of the steel thrown at her in the Yangtse about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  years ago. Another shot shows the navigator and members of her crew making surveys and soundings because of the difficulties of navigation in the river. H.M.S. AMETHYST uses her ship's boat for this work.
