

U.N. ASSEMBLY AND PEACE

In Paris, Mr. Acheson, Monsieur Schuman and Mr. Eden come to the sixth U.N. General Assembly to press America's plan for world peace. The French President sets the theme as delegates meet for the first time in their Paris Headquarters. Among American delegates are Mrs. Roosevelt and Senator Warren Austin who sees his old New York adversary Jacob Malik with Vishinsky. But hopes of early agreement fail because Andrei Vishinsky flatly turns down America's plan.
