GALES AND FLOODS STRIKE ITALY

Thirty-five were killed in falling houses, hundreds made howeless in the warst gale in fifty years, with damage stretching from Sicily to Milan. In the north wast areas were flooded around the River Po. Threatened by the mounting waters, village after village was evacuated.

Treeps joined the reacue work as the aged and the very young were taken to safer high ground.

Vast areas of farmlands were abandoned and the stock taken to safety.

In these old villages ancient homes crumbled in the wake of the rushing waters. Some escaped with a few of their goods; many were killed by falling walls while others perished in the and carried in the fleed-waters.
