VOLCANO ERUPTS IN BELGIUM CONGO

Dupenegative : 86 meters = 262 ft

Site: NYAMURAGIRA volcano in Kivu mountains of Belgian Congo,
Afrika.

This NYAMURAGIRA volcano first erupted in 1882 causing great damages, the lava flowing down near Catholic Mission towards the Edward Lake, in the valley between Rutshuru and Goma.

At that time two smaller volcano pointed out in the mountains of the surrounding country, they were the MUSHUMANGABO and the KAWAMAHARACE which erupted in 1905.

several times since 1882 did the volcano send its lava and burning stones and earth in the surroundings, in 1899, in 1920. Over 50,000 acres were covered by burning lava and the trees and vegetation entirely destroyed. The NYAMURAGIRA volcano never ceased its activity completely and for the past 50 years it has always been boiling like an enormous Devil's Caldron.

This time however it is one more in full activity and throws out great quantities of burning stones, and liquid lava which destroys everything in the country. The lava is flowing towards the Lake, and these pictures give an idea of the volcano's activity and fearful strength.
