PARATROOPS IN SUEZ ROUND-UP

Near Tel el Kebir British forces take up action positions to repel a mass attack of Egyptian terrorists. 26th Field Artillery men cross the Sweet water canal. Cameron Highlanders clean up near a burial ground from which troops were sniped during the night. Elsewhere Coldstreams operated where the Brigade of Guards won fame 70 years ago.

Near Abuweir men of the 16th Independent Parachute Brigade in a lightning raid sealed off two villages from which Egyptian guerillas had bombed and sniped our men.

Men are searched for concealed arms. In these raids Egyptian police are often found. In one, the Police Chief himself fell into the net! Generally terrorists enter the villages after dark and clear off before dawn. Sometimes they leave weapons hidden for future use. The bag here included mortar-bombs.

At El Rod Sultan it's the 1st East Lancers doing the winking out. The men are rounded up and intelligence officers check them against a Rogues Gallery in a search for known leaders. Here's one suspect held for further questioning with two others, whilst the rest are freed at once to return to normal life.
