Sunday, 20th Jan., 1952.

On Saturday, 19th January, after bomb placed on cart of oranges by Arab, exploding, killing and wounding R.A.F. Wireless Men, and wrecking car, an American nun was killed by Terrorists activities. Also intense sniping from Ismailia. (Pictures taken Saturday of this incident already sent)

General Erskine ordered town of Ismailia to be entered today. (troops of 3rd Battn Parachute Regt., Lancashire Fusiliers, and E.Lancashire Regt. took part)

A very grave view is taken of the killing of Sister Anthony, a nun of St. Vincent Convent, and General Erskine stated he would stop the activities of Terrorists who have operated from this place for some time. Saturday's incidents were more serious than before, and now the town (section Mohamed Alley) is cordoned off. Today's picture is of that operation. 41 Prisoners were taken.
