Marie BESNARD is a village woman, of over 50 years of age and she is accused of having murdered by Arseniate poison I2 persons of her connections and family to inherit their wealth. It is a regular black-roman of far off countrysides, and she new stands before her judges after 31 months of justice inquiries to find the proofs of her guilt. She has always denied the twelve or any murders, but a heavy and enermous file (over 900 different sheets of reports, in a pile of 75 centimeters high) is before the State prosesutor and Judge who intend to mentence her for her deeds. A thirteenth charge of mardering her first husband Auguste ANTIGNY has been dropped; because it is over 12 years old, but arseniate poison was also found in his remains.

Léon MESNARD died there two years ago, but before dying confided to one of her friends that she had poisoned him, as others; which started the whole accusation. While investigating for Leon Besnard's death, the police found other charges, and people in the village began talking about her whole life, and long list of inheritances and death

The man, Toussaint Rivet died in July 1959, and left Harie Besnard a sum of 178,000 Frames, his widow, Blanche RIVET died in 1941 after having sold her house agains a rent during her lifetime to Marie Besnard.
